The Stream

The Stream. That's the title of this newsletter. As I was thinking about this week's installment I thought about that image: stream. A stream is fed by springs, other creeks, run-off, and rain. Without its sources, a stream will go dry. If a stream goes dry, trees and plants, farms and even towns downstream will suffer.

If you're on the church's e-mail list you received, just <u>before</u> Thanksgiving, an appeal from me to do something I've not had to ask for very often: an appeal to <u>give</u>. Why should you give? Because our church is in the <u>best</u> business in the world--the <u>people</u> business! We (that's all of us in Christ) bring refreshing help and delightful comfort and strength to people in Laurens County every single day. Like that stream, however, without <u>our</u> many different sources, we will run dry too.

As of the end of November, just to meet our budget obligations, we need

almost \$25,000/week of undesignated giving until the end of the year. And don't forget: December is also the month for Foreign Missions giving. Our goal for that offering is \$15,000! I don't want us to short either one. They both matter and they both keep the "stream" of our work here flowing. It will be quite a challenge, I know. That's over \$140,000 in one month, just to break even.

"A Beautiful Day in the Neighborhood" is the title of our Advent message series. For the next three weeks, like Fred Rogers would (but hopefully not as cornily;-)), we'll be visiting different parts of the Advent neighborhood, getting to know its characters, and, in light of them, understanding what we can/should do. I hope you'll join us!
