We had a marvelous time of sharing and insight last night (7/12) at a called deacons meeting. The subject was our church: what's on our hearts? And what's next? Keep our leadership in your prayers, please! We believe God has great things in store for this people of God.

you, as 7/28 draws near, **(1)** to fast (to give up something) in preparation for our worship and sharing time. Fasting prepares our

minds, our hearts in ways that nothing

meditate on Colossians 3

meditate on Colossians 3:1-17. The good news is all of us are good at meditating. Meditation is worry gone positive! All of us already know how to worry. So, instead of obsessing over something you fear, turn the words of Paul over and over in your minds. (3) As you read, ask yourself, "Today, what would it look like for me to..." whatever that verse, that command addresses. Then, simply, **do** that thing (example: "clothe yourself with gentleness" [v. 12] might mean I'm extra careful with my words when I interact with my children). Let the Spirit lead you during your meditation.

Finally, I'd like you to (4) show up on July 28 with Show up three things. The

on July 28

first is an answer to two questions: Question #1—"In light of what God's been teaching you through your meditations on Colossians 3 and your personal fasting and prayer, what is God doing in this moment in our church? Question # 2—"In light of what God is doing what are you sensing we are to do?"

show up with letter ... to God on July 28 is a letter you've written to God. I encourage you to make this letter no more than one page (singlespaced, typed) in length. Use these two prompts to help you express yourself to God:

The second thing I'd like you to

- a. What I lost during these last sixteen months
- b. What I gained during these last sixteen months

Lastly, look through the Psalms (you need to start now—there are 150 of them!) and find one that best reflects the spirit of your experience in this past year-plus. You might share it at the end of your letter and why it's "your" psalm for this season in your life. Blake, bharwell@clintonfbc.us
