New Building Votes

By now you know some details about the exciting prospects our church faces in the next few months. You now know there is a vote scheduled for March 8 (that's a <u>one-service Sunday</u>, by the way) on two issues: (1) whether we will build a new building and (2) whether we will engage the South Carolina Baptist Foundation to help us with the capital campaign such an undertaking will require.

The Building Oversight Team (BOT) has been praying and meeting and hashing (and re-hashing) since last April the Lord's direction, the congregation's desires, the architect's ideas, the contractors' suggestions, the Function and Design Teams' findings. They approached the Trustees and the Deacons in the last month with tentative plans for a 16,500 square foot building located in what is now the gravel parking area. Our leader-

ship is in unanimous agreement with both recommendations: we believe God is leading us to build and we believe God has led us to the Baptist Foundation to help us raise the monies needed.

Be in prayer about these pro-

posals. And be in conversation with our BOT members and Finance Team members about them. We've set up some formal times for these conversations (this Sunday, March 1 at both 9:00 and 10:30 AM and March 4 at 6:30 PM). *Both recommendations have the unanimous consent of the FBC Trustees and Deacons.


